The Ecology Center's environmental library and resource center is open to the public and provides educational programs on environmental issues to schools and community organizations.

Residential Curbside Recycling

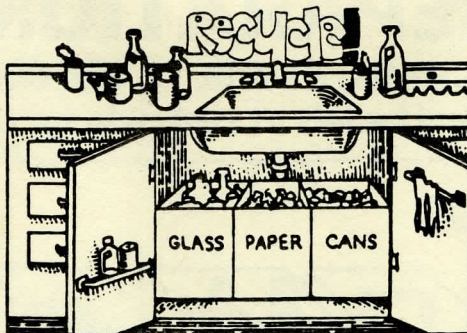
If you live within a curbside pickup area (see map insert), have your recyclables sorted and on the curb by 8 a.m.

Ecology Center Recycling Station

The recycling station is located at 2050 S. Industrial Highway and accepts all sorted recyclables.

9:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

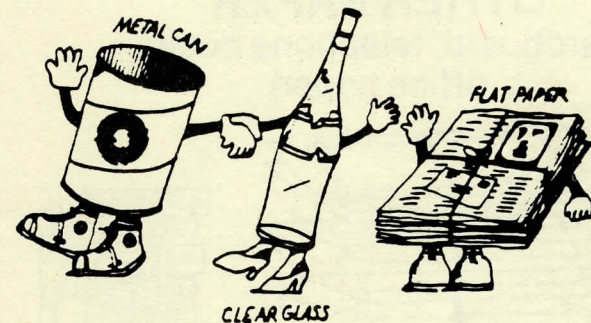

Ann Arbor's own curbside recycling service



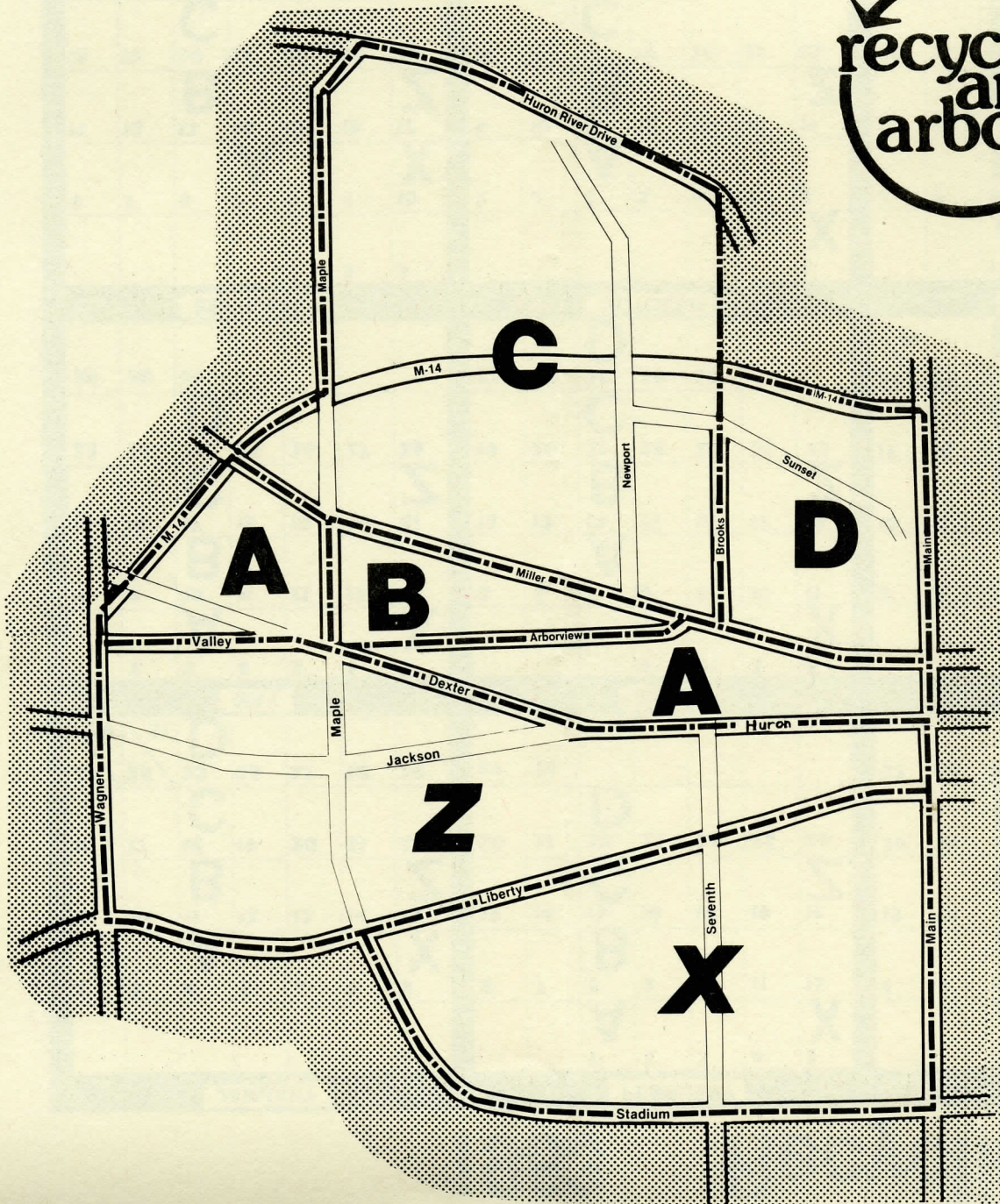

MAP OF RECYCLING AREAS

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1983



Recycle Ann Arbor of the Ecology Center hopes to provide curbside recycling service to all Ann Arbor residents by the end of 1984. This map shows the first phase of the expansion plan.

Note that areas A and B, which were formerly serviced on the third Saturday of the month will, as of January 1, 1983, have their recyclables picked up on the first or second Tuesday. Also in January, the Sister Lakes area will begin a regular curbside collection on the third Saturday of each month.

The subdivisions near Newport and Huron River Drive belong to the third Tuesday service area. Hampstead, a small township island near M-14 and Main will not be serviced.

Please check the calendar on the reverse side to note changes in your pickup day due to holidays.
