Dear George,

Based on our conversations last week, and after a review of the matter with Ecology Center staff, the Center would like to reach an agreement with the City of Ann Arbor concerning the transfer of trees from Ecology Park. As we understand it, 16 of the 18 interior trees belong to the Ecology Center, and the remaining two are property of the city.

We propose to donate thẽ 16 trees to the city if your department can remove and replant them at no cost to the Center. Our hope is that the trees would be relocated in a city park and that some public recognition of the donation would be included.

If this is a workable plan, we are prepared to move quickly to expedite the process so that the trees can be safely moved within the next 30 to 45 days.

At one point in our discussions you mentioned saving the various shrubs left in the park. Perhaps we could explore this issue at greater length in the near future.
