Empty cans, bottles, and other non-returnable containers are seriously depleting our non-renewable natural resources and are cluttering our surroundings. These containers are being used up at an astronomical rate: 26 billion bottles and 48 billion cans last year. We are running out of materials to make these cans. We are running out of places to hide them. The mountain of cans is rising.

As concerned individuals, we feel that the University should initiate action to end this problem. As immediate action we demand that the University change its contract with the Coca-Cola Company and Servomation, Inc. to ban the use of non-returnable containers in their vending machines.

Furthermore we demand that the Coca-Cola Company and all other beverage manufacturers completely abolish the manufacture and use of non-returnable containers and return to returnables.
