1. Sign up 100+ Michigan groups in support of the campaign

2. Get 10,000 signatures on petitions to support the legislation and the campaign

A petition drive to support the campaign is being launched with a goal of 10,000 signatures by the end of the year

3. Write, phone and lobby state legislators to support the Right to Act legislation

The Right to Act Campaign is urging activists to support our state legislation as well as national legislation: The national OSHA reform legislation needs the support of environmental as well as labor activists, and the package of bills known as the War on Waste legislation needs continued activist support

4. Initiate dialogue between labor and community groups across the state
