PETITION

We, the undersigned registered voters of Scio Township, strongly object to the discharge into Honey Creek or its tributaries of any effluent contaminated with 1,4-dioxane at concentrations greater than 3 ppb. The current proposal is to discharge 60-100 ppb, risking the health and well being of citizens as well as the value and utility of real property. We therefore support the resolution of the Scio Township Board of Trustees which has placed a proposal on the ballot of the November 8, 1994 election. A non-renewable 0.50 mill tax increase for a three year period is proposed, with revenues to be used exclusively to finance and support legal and operational activities to oppose dumping of groundwater contaminated in excess of 3 ppb into Honey Creek, and to monitor any future discharge of 1,4-dioxane that may occur. (A 0.50 mill increase will increase the taxes on a \$100,000 home (true cash value) by \$25 per year.)
